New Admin UI

The New Admin UI announced in the [August Release](#) will be rolled out in waves for all accounts starting at the end of September. Please contact your CSM for wave dates.

Account Administrators (users with the Manage Users permission) can access the Account Dashboard and enable the “New Admin Design” to proactively switch to enable the New UI.

New Events page (formerly My Webcasts page)

All accounts that have activated the New Admin UI will see a new Events page. This newly built and redesigned Events page replaces the legacy My Webcasts page.

The new Events page features include:

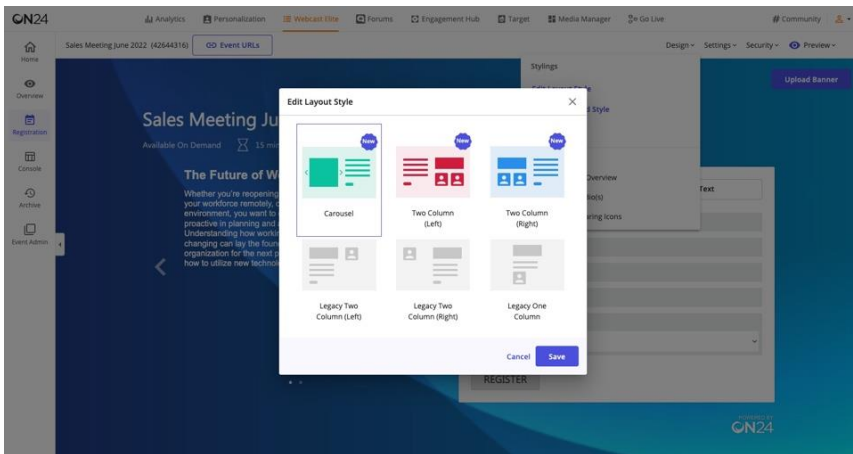
- An improved search filter and quick access tabs for selecting all events, upcoming events, and past events.
- A new pagination option allows you to set the number of items per page which display as follows: 25, 50, and 100.
- Improved Event Information and Warning messages can be accessed to alert you of problems when creating your event.

Note: The All Events tab will display the latest upcoming and past events up to a maximum of 400 events in total (200 upcoming and 200 past). To see events outside of that range, adjust your To and From date filters.

Registration Builder Layout Options

In the [August Release](#), we launched registration builder layouts. In this release, you will see Registration/Lobby Page layout options for both the **new** Registration/Lobby page layouts and the **legacy** Registration/Lobby page layouts.

Blur Background for ON24 Forums, Breakouts, ON24 Go Live

Please note that we had to temporarily disable Blur background feature for ON24 Forums, Breakouts, and ON24 Go Live and a fix will be in a future release. The Blur background will still be available in ON24 Webcast Elite.

“Anonymous” Display Name

Please note that we had to temporarily disable the option for mobile users to join as Anonymous in ON24 Forums and ON24 Breakout experiences. Mobile users will need to join with First Name and Last Name or First Name and Last Initial, unless “Anonymous” was selected as a setting during configuration. There is no impact to desktop users. Please stay tuned for upcoming release details for when this feature returns.

Additional Fixes:

- Fixed – For New Admin Overview page, an issue with the email reminder custom date and time logic where an error message was displaying when trying to set a future date.
- Fixed - For New Admin Overview page, another email issue where after the email was sent, the custom fields were not being disabled.
- Fixed - For New Admin Overview page, an issue while uploading a large file, users were being logged out in the middle of the file upload.
- Fixed - For New Admin Overview page, an issue where the calendar reminders were displaying code in the sent reminder.
- Fixed - For New Admin Overview page, an issue with uploading PowerPoint presentations to the Overview page.
- Fixed - For New Admin, an issue with the One-Click Registration page functionality.
- Fixed – For Legacy Admin, an issue with the Legacy Multi-Reg page where there were errors when selecting and unselecting events past the page limit of 100.
- Fixed – For both live captions and on-demand captions, attendees were not able to turn the captions off. This happened when one caption language was set up.
- Fixed – When applying a template to an event, and the template included a Certification tool that was configured to use the automated attendance check feature, the event was not correctly launching the automated attendance checks.

- Fixed – For breakout rooms configured to appear at the end of the webinar, if the attendee joins a room, and then leaves the room, the attendee was not given the opportunity to join another room or the same room. This occurred when the “Show on launch” attribute was unchecked for the Breakout Room tool.
- Fixed – In a sim2live event that was copied or imported from a source event with whiteboarding and pointer actions from Elite Studio, the whiteboarding and pointer actions were not reflected on the console during the “Sim” portion of the event.
- Fixed – In both the Attendee Chat tool and the breakout room chat, the emoji representing the middle finger has been removed from the emoji selection list.
- Fixed – When using the “Embedded Chrome Shown on Hover” setting within Console Customization for a Live Audio event, on the archive recording of the event, when hovering over the Media Player, the icons were not showing up correctly.
- Fixed – On a small browser screen, when joining a breakout rooms, the “Terms of use” link was overlapping with the join button.
- Fixed – For mobile attendees on an event configured with both a Breakout Room and the Reactions tools, after joining the breakout room, chat was not working unless the attendee refreshed their browser.
